

## **Fuel Up to Play 60 Offers up to \$4,000 Per School**

Fuel Up to Play 60, the free in-school nutrition and physical activity program, offers funding to help schools implement the program. The competitive funding initiative provides money to help schools jumpstart and sustain healthy nutrition and physical activity improvements. Any U.S. school can enroll in the free program and thus be eligible to apply for up to \$4,000 to help increase awareness of and access to nutrient-rich foods and physical activity opportunities for students.

The funds can be used for a variety of activities and tools, from resources that help enhance students' healthy eating (such as foodservice equipment and nutrition education materials) to items that help schools address students' physical activity needs (such as exercise equipment and student and staff incentives).
