Candidate Qualifications

The candidate must:

- A. Have been a member in good standing for the five years immediately preceding nomination, and:
- B. Made significant scholarly contributions to the profession while residing in South Carolina. "Scholarly" shall be construed to include research, publications, and/or presentations that contribute to the knowledge that underlies the profession OR "creative publication" which may include visual and sonic recordings of public performances of creative endeavors as well as typological presentations that break new ground.

By August 1st, please submit to the Committee Chair a resume, which ONLY contains the following:

- 1. Your Name
- 2. Business Address
- 3. Business Telephone
- 4. Earned Degrees (school, degree & date, major, minor)
- 5. Positions held since 1990 (a change in rank counts as a new position)
- 6. Scholarly research
- 7. Scholarly publications
- 8. Scholarly presentations

Additionally, with your resume please submit:

Photocopies or email your three (3) most scholarly publications or a visual (or sonic) recording of three (3) of your most creative works. (Videotapes should be in VHS format or DVD formats acceptable).
