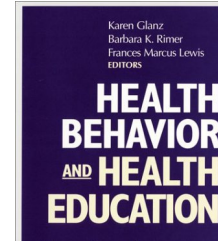
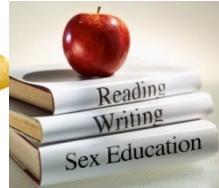


Benefits of SCAHPERD
