ADVOCACY AWARD

The Advocacy Award recognizes a person who has significantly promoted and/or advanced the mission of the Dance Association in South Carolina

- ❖ Be a resident of South Carolina
- ❖ The recipient shall have promoted/advanced the mission of the Association through sustained significant contributions in one or more of the following areas:
 1. Education
 2. Legislation or regulation
 3. Community and/or Statewide programs
 4. Personal leadership, with integrity in non-traditional areas

DANCE EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR

The Dance Educator of the Year Award recognizes a teacher who exemplifies the best practices in the delivery of dance education curriculum and who represents the best role model for students and other teachers in the field of dance education.

- ❖ Be a current member in good standing of the Association
- ❖ Have a minimum of two years teaching experience in South Carolina before the nomination year
- ❖ Teaching assignment must be at least fifty percent in the area of dance education during the two years preceding the nomination year and at the time of the presentation of the award
- ❖ Be under contract with a South Carolina school district with a teaching assignment of at least fifty percent in the area of dance education during the nomination year and at the time of the presentation of the award
- ❖ Be known for high professional and personal standards and performance
- ❖ Be a worthy role model
